

Gift Aid Declaration

FoGM can reclaim basic rate tax on all gifts, provided that you have paid an amount of UK income or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax we reclaim.

This means every £1 donated is worth £1.25 (the difference paid by HM Customs and Revenue) at no cost to you.
