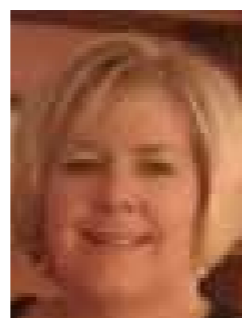

### Arrival and Check in

**Please inform the check in desk of your arrival in each venue. Players must arrive at least 20 minutes prior to their first match.**

### Video/Camera Guidelines

Please note the following guidelines must be adhered to in relation to any video/camera activity at the event, by signing the video permission form you are agreeing to the following:

- Videoing/Photography is permitted only following completion, and subsequent authorisation, of a child protection and vulnerable adult video/photography pass form (available from Match Control)
- The decision of the Referee/organisation committee will be final and permission may be retracted at any time.
- Players, coaches/parents must advise the referee on arrival if they do not wish to be included in photographs or film footage which may be taken over the three days of competition.

### Matchplay

The tournament will be played in full accordance with the laws of Badminton and Competition Regulations adopted by BADMINTONscotland as well as the regulations of the BWF

### Clothing/Advertising

Clothing and advertising must conform to the BWF Regulations.

### Prior to the match

When each match is called players should report to match control to collect the match slip and shuttle.

### Shuttles

Yonex AS30 will be used throughout the tournament - if players wish to tip shuttles they should first consult the referee / depute referee / roving umpire

### Warming up

Due to a tight schedule, no courts are available for warming up

### Knock up

Knock up time should be kept to a minimum

### Scoreboards

Scoreboards will be available for all matches. Please take the opportunity to score matches during your time with us! Scorers are not permitted to intervene in any aspect of the match

## Team Sheets

Team composition sheets (hand out) should be passed to the referee / depute referee at least 30 minutes before each match – a match sheet will then be given to each team manager to check and a final sheet with results will be signed after each match.

## Group stage

All matches must be completed during group stage.

## Play offs

The match will be terminated when either team reaches 3 wins.

## Umpires

A roving umpire will be available throughout the tournament and line judges may be available on request – if there are any on court problem please involve referee immediately.

## Coaching

Coaching breaks will be permitted.

## Ranking order

The final league ranking order shall be established as follows – (BWF rules)

- Positions will be decided by the number of matches won.
- If 2 teams win the same number of matches the winner of the match between them will be placed higher.
- If 3 teams win the same number of matches positions will be decided by rubbers difference – if this leaves 2 teams the same then the winner of the match between them will be placed higher.
- If 3 teams win the same number of matches and have equal rubbers difference positions will be decided by games difference – if this leaves 2 teams the same then the winner of the match between them will be placed higher.
- If 3 teams win the same number of matches have equal rubbers difference and equal games difference positions will be decided by points difference – if this leaves 2 teams the same then the winner of the match between them will be placed higher.

- If 3 teams are still equal positions will be decided by drawing lots.

(a 10minute break if required)

Any change to the order should be agreed by the teams and the referee.

## Intervals/Coaching

After 11 points, players are allowed to have a 60 second interval.

- Between each game, players are allowed 120 second interval.
- Coaches should leave the court 20 seconds prior to the end of each break

## After the match

The winner of each match should fill out the match slip and both players should bring this back to match control

## Individual ranking

The final order within the groups will be as follows:

- Positions will be decided by the number of rubbers won.
- If 2 players/pairs win the same number of rubbers the winner of the rubber between them will be placed higher.
- If 3 or more players/pairs win the same number of rubbers, positions will be decided by games difference – if this leaves 2 players/pairs the same then the winner of the rubber between them will be placed higher.
- If 3 or more players/pairs win the same number of rubbers and have equal games difference, positions will be decided by points difference – if this leaves 2 players/pairs the same then the winner of the rubber between them will be placed higher.
- If 3 or more players/pairs are still equal, positions will be decided by drawing lots.

## Insurance

The Organisers decline responsibility and covering of costs for possible injuries or other damages. It is up to participants to insure themselves.

## Physiotherapy

A limited physiotherapist service will be present in GSOS and NBA during the championships.

## Prizes

Gold, Silver and Bronze Medals will be awarded.

## Court Officials

Semi-finals and finals will be led by BADMINTONscotland Court Officials supported by young scorers from Scotstoun Junior Badminton Club

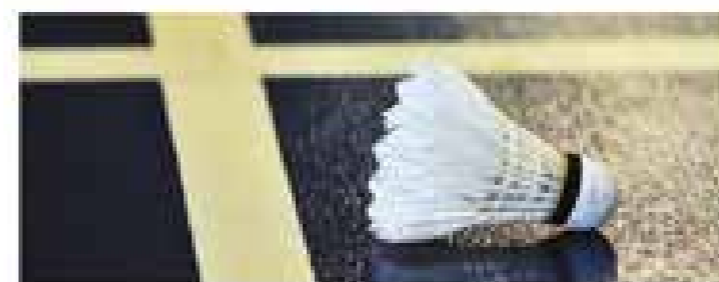
