**ART - Gorbals' Art and Sculpture**

Explore the results of the 'percent for art' redevelopment clause.

**HISTORY – William Wallace Circular & Robroyston Park**

Discover Wallace Well, built on a natural spring, where it is thought William Wallace took his last drink as a free man.

**NATURE - Auchenshuggle Woods & River Clyde**

Escape city streets on a woodland and riverside walk.
