

## Glasgow Sport Voluntary Coach and Officials Award

The Glasgow Sport Coach and Officials Award is designed to support volunteer sports coaches and officials by providing funding towards education, development and training.

### Quick Guide

1. Glasgow Sport can support volunteer coaches attending a **UKCC Level 1, Level 2 or equivalent** course and relevant official's courses to a maximum of **£250**.
2. If attending a UKCC endorsed course, you may be entitled to a course subsidy through **sportscotland**. Details regarding the subsidy can be found [here](#).
3. Applicants should check eligibility and apply at least **3 weeks** prior to the course.
4. Applicants must pay for the course up front and submit confirmation of acceptance and payment along with their application to this fund.
5. Glasgow Life will advise the outcome within **6 weeks** of receiving the application.
6. The funding should be claimed via the return of all necessary paperwork to Glasgow Life within **6 weeks** of completing the course. Failure to do so may result in funding being withdrawn.
7. Candidates will be asked to submit a short impact report regarding the funding received. Failure to complete this will affect future funding.

<b>Who is the award for?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Volunteers within Glasgow based sports clubs.</li> <li>• Volunteers within Glasgow Sport programmes.</li> <li>• Individuals who want to volunteer for a Glasgow club or programme but require the necessary qualifications.</li> </ul>
<b>Who can't apply</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Paid coaches who do not volunteer.</li> <li>• Coaches from 'for profit' organisations.</li> <li>• Coaches and Officials not volunteering within Glasgow.</li> </ul>
<b>What will we fund?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• NGB or <b>sportscotland</b> recognised courses.</li> <li>• UKCC Level 1 or Level 2 courses or equivalent.</li> <li>• Approved NGB courses for officials.</li> </ul>
<b>What won't we be able to fund?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Courses that have already taken place or have started.</li> <li>• UKCC Level 3 or above and equivalent courses.</li> <li>• The full cost of the course if a subsidy is available i.e. Details on <b>sportscotland</b> subsidy can be found <a href="#">here</a></li> </ul>
<b>How much can I apply for?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Applicants can apply for <b>£250</b> of the remaining cost following subsidy. Glasgow Sport will determine the amount to be allocated to any successful application.</li> </ul>
<b>Key Information</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All funding is retrospective and payment is made upon receipt of necessary paperwork.</li> <li>• All funding in place for the course must be indicated on the application form.</li> <li>• Applicants are expected to cover the remaining balance of the course regardless of the funding panel decision.</li> <li>• The awards panel decision is final.</li> </ul>
