

Glasgow Sport Athlete and Officials Travel Award

The Glasgow Sport Athlete and Officials Travel Award provides funding support to athletes attending competition outwith Scotland that requires qualification or selection by their governing body.

Quick Guide

1. To be eligible for funding from this award applicants must be Glasgow residents.
2. Glasgow Sport supports athletes and officials that have qualified or been selected for performance competition. To be eligible the competition must be supported and endorsed by the appropriate sport governing body.
3. Applications will only be considered for competitions outside of Scotland.
4. Glasgow Sport can support applications to eligible competitions up to a maximum of **£250** for individuals and **£500** for groups.
5. Applicants should check eligibility and apply for the Athlete and Officials Travel Fund **2 months prior to the departure date**.
6. Glasgow Sport will advise of the outcome within **6 weeks** of receiving application.
7. Applicants must claim the funds via the return of the necessary paperwork and confirmation of travel plan within **1 month** of their award email.
8. Applicants will be asked to submit a short impact report after attendance at the competition. Failure to do so will affect future funding.

Who is the award for?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glasgow residents or sports organisations applying on behalf of Glasgow residents at an eligible competition. • All clubs and groups should be affiliated to their NGB.
What competitions are eligible for this award?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Competitions that require qualification or selection. • Competitions that are supported and endorsed by the relevant governing body. • Competitions that are outside Scotland.
What is the maximum level of award:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Maximum award of £250 for individual applications. • Maximum award of £500 for group applications.
What applications would not be eligible for this award:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Competitions that are not recognised by the NGB or do not require qualification and/or selection to compete. • Competitions that have already taken place. • Competitions that take place in Scotland.
Key Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successful awards will receive payment when necessary paperwork is completed and returned. • Expenditure information to be available on request. • Awards will not be made to schools, colleges or university applications. • The awards panel decision is final.
